In sentence 4 a contrast is shown, hence 'but' is more suitable. Hence BAABA.

In option A, "raise" is a wrong usage, because "raise" cannot be accompanied by "to the ground". The correct usage is "razed the castle to the ground". Hence, the right answer choice is option A.


