


WORKSPACE

Answer cues

- Draw the elements of design - circles and squares as instructed.
- Choose the complementary colour scheme (Red & Green, Blue & Orange) and assign colours to the elements.
- Create a pattern by overlay & repetition of elements
- Apply any one principle of designs to make a composition

Make an interesting composition using cubes and cones of various sizes placed on the table. Draw shades and shadows assuming the light source.


Answer cues

Step 02: Cast the shadow using the light from top left corner (Hint: Assume Light Source).

Answer cues

- Choose vibrant colours for eye-catching appeal.
- Aim for a modern, abstract design reflecting Sveta's passion for flowers.

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WORKSPACE

You're at your grandfather's century-old traditional courtyard house. Upon entering, you're greeted by a courtyard enclosed by numerous traditional columns. Your grandfather sits relaxed in a chair facing the courtyard, while your grandmother dries chillies nearby. Sketch this scene in pencil.

Answer cues

- Its a one point perspective of a courtyard house
- Draw horizon line.
- Place single vanishing point.
- Sketch courtyard with traditional columns.
- Add traditional tulsi mandapam at center.
- Include large water vessel and containers. Depict hanging clothes.
- Show grandfather in chair, grandmother drying chillies nearby. Add shading and details for completion.

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WORKSPACE

As he looked at his assortment of stationery and geometry tools, he decided to arrange them in a playful manner to provide a temporary distraction. Surprisingly, his playful arrangement sparked his creativity, leading him to construct an intricate 3D sculpture. If you were in Dev's position, how would you go about creating a three-dimensional composition?

Answer cues

- View pencils, erasers, sharpeners as cuboids.
- Consider scales, protractor, set squares as planar elements.
- Paper weights can represent cubes or pyramids.
- Pencil holders are cylindrical in shape.
- Experiment with stacking, interlocking, and arranging blocks in different ways.
- Utilize voids in elements to create empty spaces.
- Choose a design principle to guide composition.
